**Spirit-steps**

Most of my New Year's resolutions center around one of two themes: 1) eat less, and 2) move more.

It's a cruel irony that bids us resolve to eat less while the fridge is still full of Christmas leftovers. That's the first one I break.

To help me do better on the second one, I was recently gifted with a watch that counts how many steps I take in a day. It even beep-beep-beeps to remind me to get up if I sit too long. I like it, but often I forget to put it on.

One beautiful Saturday last fall, I got up early, stepped into my shoes and out the door, and found myself on a walk. I listened to birds, scanned the woods for deer and picked up a few dead branches for our next fire. As I headed home it hit me: I should have put the step-counter on! That walk would have really helped my day's goal. I couldn't help feeling those steps had been wasted.

Then another thought hit me: What's more important? That the steps got measured? Or that they got taken?

In Galatians 5, Paul lays out for us the fruits the Holy Spirit bears in our lives: love, joy and peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. He closes by saying, in verse 25, "Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit."

Spirit-steps — walking where Jesus leads us, living his example, showing his love to those around us — can't be counted by any device known to man. But even one can change a life.

So this is your beep-beep-beep. You've been sitting too long. Get up! Take that step! And don't worry about measurements.

I'm pretty sure God's the only one who can count that high.
