Satan hates joy.

Joy conveys contentment and hope. Joy is a product of gratitude. Joy encourages and builds and carries one along. It is the current of happiness. Joy delights in the simple. Joy smiles at the success of others. Joy is never jealous. Joy is the attitude of grace exhibited on the face. Joy fills the heart and overflows from a well-spring of abundance. 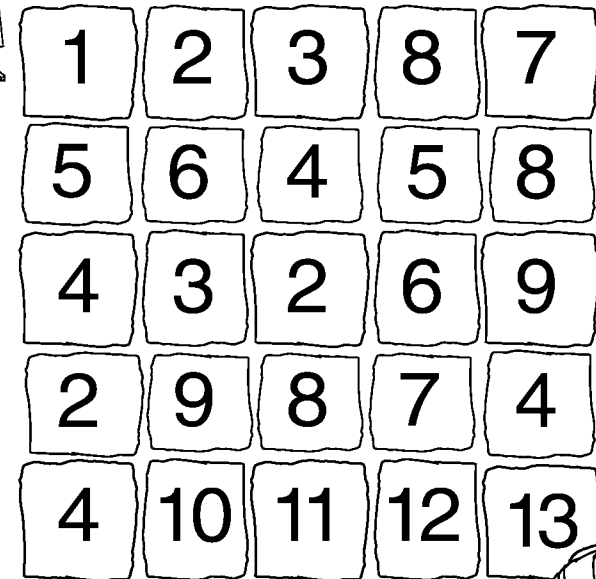

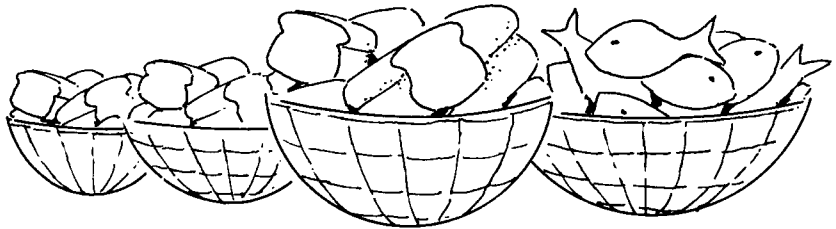
