INTERN INSIGHTS

In John chapter 4 there is a powerful story that takes place, and I’ve drawn a couple of key takeaways for us to look at that I think we can apply to ourselves. Last week Bradley wrote a great piece about the Bible pointing to Jesus the whole way through. In it he mentioned this story in John 4 about the Samaritan woman at the well with Jesus. Today I’d like to add to his insights, analyzing this story from a different angle. There are two things that really stuck out to me while reading this story, and they’re all about spreading the best news ever. The first point is this: the woman influences the people around her. Look how one encounter changed lives from John 4:39: “Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman’s testimony, ‘He told me everything I ever did.’” Once Jesus reveals who he is, the woman immediately drops what she is doing in verse 28, and shares her encounter with the Messiah. She has a community that she lives in, and she runs to tell them. That brings us to the second point: the woman is unashamed. The people she is telling know her and the reputation she has. This could be why she is drawing water at “about noon,” an unusual and probably hot time to draw water. But whatever feelings made her draw water at this time of day with nobody around immediately went away. The encounter she had with Jesus drives away all her shame and fears, and drives her to share the name of Jesus with her community. The Samaritan woman became an evangelist, and this one encounter with Jesus led to many people exclaiming this amazing truth, “now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world.” Steele Pennington
