Hallmarks - "FURIOUS SQUALL" - by Lance Hall

A "furious squall" sounds terrifying! In Mark 4, Jesus and the disciples are attempting to cross the lake when they encounter a "furious squall". This must have been one vicious storm. It has the disciples extremely anxious. Many of these men had spent hours of their lives on the water and would have been adept at navigating whatever the lake might throw at them. With that said, this storm has them shook. They run to Jesus, only to find Him asleep, gently being rocked by the storm's waves. The disciples woke Him with a question: "Jesus, don't you care if we drown?" Jesus sees the fear in their eyes and hears the desperation in their voices. He stands up and utters three words, "Quiet! Be still!" At His voice, the storm comes to an abrupt end. The wind and the waves obey. The lightning and the rain heed His words. In the peaceful stillness, Jesus looks toward His disciples and asks, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" As I considered this story and the state of our world, I could almost hear Jesus asking me these same questions. If you pay attention to the news, it does not take long to see we live in a "furious squall". It is easy to be afraid and to have my faith shaken. May I remember that God is with me on the journey, that I needn't be anxious, and that He alone can speak the words of peace over a chaotic world. May I put my faith in Him and Him alone, for there is no other name under heaven which can save me.
