Hallmarks "Peace be with you" - by Lance Hall

As I read John 20:19-23, I was struck by the phrase "Peace be with you." These words are spoken when Jesus suddenly appears among the disciples after the resurrection and again before Jesus says He is sending them out. This greeting of peace is comforting. This offer of peace is needed. Peace is rare in our world today, but I guess it always has been. There are so many things that steal our peace. From news of major wars to relationship struggles to the battles that rage in our minds...and so much more. This passage reminds me that Jesus is the source of all comfort. He is my refuge. He is the only one who can provide true peace for my life. As I thought about Jesus saying "Peace be with you" to the disciples that day as he prepared to send them out, I was reminded of how little peace there is when we are not walking in step with the Lord. Jesus offered peace, and then He sent them. If the disciples had not been willing to go where Jesus was sending them, I doubt they would have experienced much peace. I think the same is true of us. We experience the greatest level of peace when we live in step with the Spirit and go where Jesus leads us. This is true even when the places He leads us to are difficult. This is why we can experience supernatural peace in the midst of hard situations and circumstances. If I choose to plot my own path to peace and refuse to go where Jesus leads me, the results are sure to be lackluster. Even if outwardly, my situation looks safe and calm and holds the appearance of peace, the inner turmoil and mental gymnastics going on between my ears (from the knowledge that I am not where God has called me) are anything but peaceful. The peace that passes understanding is readily found when I am willing to live in submission to the King. This passage challenged me to go where I am sent, to experience peace from the One who has all authority, and to remember that the Holy Spirit inside of me is a powerful travel companion.
