There is a moment throughout most days that is special to moms and kids. The moment follows a brief separation, possibly for school or work. That separation is ended with the words, “Hi Mom!” There is always a story at this point. “You won’t believe what happened today.” It really doesn’t matter whether mom or the child makes the statement. The ball is rolling and the conversation unfolds to reveal matters of vital importance. The words are not really that important – but the communication is vital. These stories are unguarded, unfiltered messages. They reveal frustration or joy. They carry hope or discouragement. They are freely offered in a safe environment where they can be met with empathy and processed helpfully.

These moments change as years go by. I have noticed that they still really serve much the same role in communication. The phone rings and Marleen picks up and someone says, “Hi Mom!” Off they go on a vital subject. **The subject is “someone is willing to listen and care about my life.”** What a blessing. The matter goes both ways. Mom knows someone loves them and cares enough to share life with them. Sometimes those moments are hours long. Sometimes they are a brief “hug” of communication. These moments are critical to one’s health and relationship.

I am concerned about the number of folks that don’t have anyone to talk to. They are constantly posting and texting and calling but they really don’t feel they have anyone that sees and cares.

This is where prayer enters the picture. Imagine being able to open your heart and lift it to God with the same vigor. “Hi Mom!” God made moms. God fills that role for us. God longs to hear our hearts, share our life and process our unspeakable need.
