Intern Insights by Ansel Caddell

As we prepare for our mission trip to High Plains Children's Home, I am reminded of the past experiences I have been blessed with on this trip. What has always stuck out the most to me on this trip, is the total absorption of the children we meet into our youth group. While initially there is a reasonable hesitancy from some of the children to connect with our group, our attempts to display Christ's love break down these barriers. By the end of the week, the initial awkwardness between the two groups is gone, and the children have almost completely integrated within our youth. What I find very incredible about these connections, is that oftentimes when talking to these children, it is very difficult to find a common ground at the start. You speak with the residents and try to find shared interests, and start to wonder what you could possibly have in common with this person in order to make a connection. And while we may share very little in regards to our interests and personal background, we share a quality in the fact that Jesus loves us and desires a relationship with us. This single truth is infinitely more than enough to overcome any barrier we face in our efforts to connect with these residents. While it is our intention to impact these individuals who have undergone so many hardships, it is usually the case that the strength and optimism these children maintain despite life's unrelenting challenges, inspire us volunteers far more than anything we ever could have done in our time spent in Amarillo. As you go forth in your lives, keep in mind the power in Jesus' love for you, and find encouragement in the truth that His patient, sacrificial, and forgiving love breaks barriers and allows for growth and fellowship in the unlikeliest of places.
