Intern Insights by Landon Brajnik 6/14/26

"The lot is cast into the lap, but its every decision is from the Lord." These words from Proverbs 16:33 make a profound statement on God's relationship to even the most ordinary events that happen in our lives. Before we can understand how this might apply to us today, let's first get a better grasp of how this wisdom plays out in Scripture, by looking at a peculiar story in the first chapter of Acts.

Wedge in between Jesus' ascension and the Day of Pentecost, we read the account of Matthias replacing the deceased Judas in the ministry of the apostles. The decision came down to two men, Josph (called Barsabbas) and Matthias, both equally qualified to take the position (1:21-22). The believers then did what any reasonable person would have done faced with such an important choice: they flipped a coin. Acts 1:26 says, "they cast lots, and the lot fell to Matthias; so he was added to the eleven apostles." We can begin to see Proverbs 16:33 at work in this story. Instead of leaving the decision to themselves, the believers sought the Lord and casts lots to hear his answer, a practice that was common in Ancient Israel (Lev 16:6-10, Jos 18:6-10, 1 Sam 10:20-21, 14:41-42).

Tellingly, this story in Acts is the last mention of lots in the New Testament. I believe that in the Scriptures God has given us everything we need to discern his will, making it unnecessary to flip a coin when a decision must be made. Nonetheless, we can still find comfort in the words of Proverbs 16:33, knowing that our experiences in this life are not determined by the random roll of the dice, but by the Lord who *"causes everything to work together for the good of those who love Him."* (Rom 8:28).
